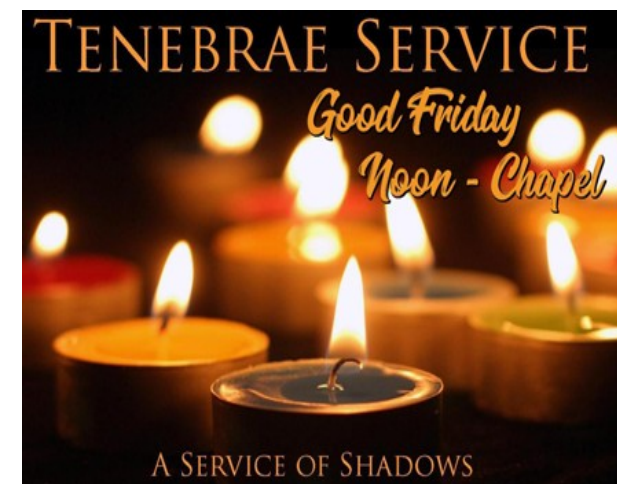

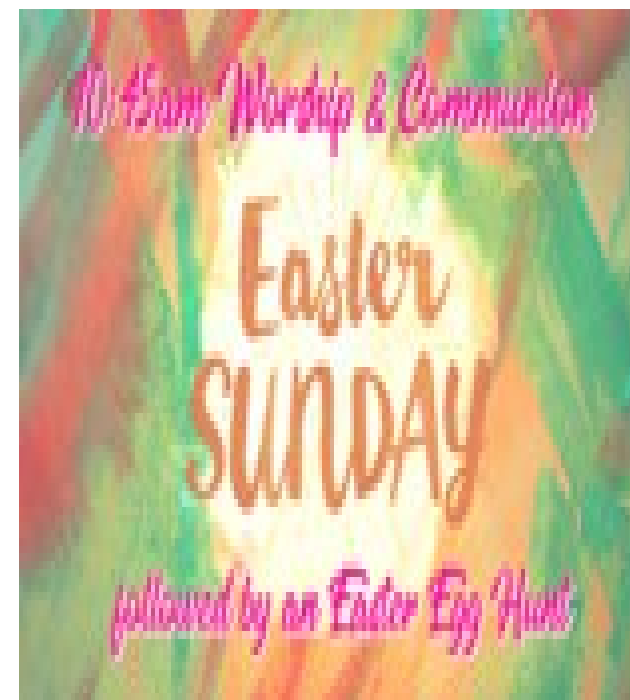
Christians Concerned, a United Way Agency, is a non-profit, volunteer organization dedicated to helping those in need in the Duncan area.
